The Bluegrass Alliance for Women will offer two \$500, non-renewable scholarship to women and girls who have demonstrated strong leadership skills and a commitment to volunteer service. One will be awarded to a traditional student (attending college immediately after high school or current GED graduate) and one for a nontraditional student. The Legacy of Leadership Scholarship is available to female residents of one of the Bluegrass Areas Development District Counties (Anderson, Bourbon, Boyle, Clark, Estill, Fayette, Franklin, Garrard, Harrison, Jessamine, Lincoln, Madison, Mercer, Nicholas, Powell, Scott, and Woodford). **The scholarship is open to women and girls who will be attending college as a full-time student or a part-time student carrying nine credit hours.**
